

Ordinance Number 25.

Be it ordained by the Village Council of the town of Washburn, of the County of Mc Lean and State of North Dakota;

Section 1. That permission and authority is hereby given and granted to the Standard Oil Company, a corporation, organized and doing business under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Indiana, to construct and maintain for a term of fifty(50) years the following described property; On the right of way of the Soo Railroad Company, at a place to be decided by the said mentioned Standard Oil Company and Soo Railway Company, ware houses, tanks and other buildings necessary for its business, and to store therein illuminating oils, naptha, gasoline, benzine and other mineral oils or fluid the products of petroleum in quantities sufficient to meet the requirements of its business.

Section 2. All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 3. All notices required to be published under this ordinance shall be published but once, and shall be deemed completed on the day of publication hereof.

Section 4. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication.

Introduced at a special meeting of the village board, held January 26, 1906, and passed February 6, 1906, at a regular meeting of the said village board.
