

**Washburn City Commission  
Special Meeting  
October 5, 2012 7:00 pm**

**The Washburn City Commission met for Special Meeting on Monday October 5, 2012 at 7:00 pm in the Washburn Memorial Building Basement. The following Commissioners were present: Commissioner Laning, Bauer, Barnick, Baumann and Moran, Commissioners Absent: none**

**Commissioner Bauer called the meeting to order.**

**Bauer announced this Public Meeting was for information on the Street projects in 2013 and welcomed all the residents' in attendance. Participants that would like to comment on the proposal were asked to please step up to podium and give their name and address before speaking to keep order in the meeting. Introductions were made of the City Commission, City Auditor and the City Engineer.**

**Bauer announced the City is looking for volunteers to join the Special Assessment Commission. The Special Assessment Commission is comprised of three members and the City of Washburn is in need of two seats to be filled. Anyone interested can call the Washburn City Office.**

**Bauer then turned the meeting over to Commissioner Laning, Street Commissioner, and Jasper Klein of AE2S, City Engineer, who explained the proposed street projects for 2013. Klein presented a map and list of the streets that are proposed to be rehabilitated; Roughrider Road, portion of Border Lane, Northgate Drive, 4<sup>th</sup> Avenue, 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue, 7<sup>th</sup> Street, 6<sup>th</sup> Avenue, Renner Addition streets, Sundown Addition streets. Klein gave a brief overview of the projects proposed in each area. Laning explained that some of the patching projects were changed in 2012 due to the proposal of the street project for 2013.**

**Laning open the floor to any residents that would like to comment;**

**A number of residents present voiced concerns on the projects, gave ideas and discussed past projects in the areas under consideration. Other topic discussed were Special Assessments, types of material that could be used on the roads, other roads that may need repairs in the future and the use of the Sales and Use funds for street projects,**

**The Commission thanked all residents for coming to the meeting and voicing their suggestions and concerns.**
