

Ordinance No. 131

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING REGULATIONS CONCERNING CURFEWS

The City Commission of the City of Washburn, North Dakota, does hereby ordain as follows:

**Curfew.** It is unlawful for persons under the age of sixteen years to loiter, idle, wander, stroll, play in or upon, or drive or ride about in a vehicle or be in or upon the public streets, highways, roads, alleys, or public buildings, places or grounds between the hours of 10:30 p.m. and 5:00 a.m., and it is unlawful for a person sixteen years of age but not yet eighteen years of age to loiter, idle, wander, stroll, play in or upon, or drive or ride about in a vehicle or be in or upon the public streets, highways, roads, alleys or other public buildings, places or grounds between the hours of 1:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. This section does not apply to persons accompanied by a parent, guardian or other adult person having their care, custody, or to persons upon emergency errands, or legitimate business directed by their parent, guardian or other adult person having their care and custody, or to persons traveling to or from a location outside the city on legitimate business or with the consent of a parent or guardian. This section also does not apply to a person in attendance at, or traveling between that person's home and a place of legitimate employment or an event or activity sponsored by or associated with a school, church, or similar organization, or an organized sporting, political, theatric or other like event or activity, within thirty minutes of the end of the work shift or the conclusion of the event or activity.

**Violations.** A violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed an offense.
