

ORDINANCE NO. 93

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE POSSESSION OF WEAPONS AND FIREARMS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF WASHBURN, McLEAN COUNTY, NORTH DAKOTA

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WASHBURN.

SECTION 1. No person in the City of Washburn shall have in his possession any of the following weapons or firearms unless they are carried in the prosecution of or to effect a lawful and legitimate purpose:

- A. Any instrument or weapon of the kind usually known as a blackjack, slung shot, billy, sandclub, sandbag, bludgeon, metal knuckles, switchblade knife of any length, mechanically opening knife of any length; and
- B. Any gun or firearm.


SECTION 2. The above prohibition shall not apply to:

- 1. A gun or firearm carried on his own land, in his own abode or fixed place of business or on a target range.
- 2. Unstrung bow, unloaded firearm in a vehicle or elsewhere when such firearm is unloaded and properly cased.

SECTION 3. PENALTY: Any person violating any provisions of this ordinance shall upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine not to exceed \$500.00 or by imprisonment by a term not exceeding 30 days or both such fine and imprisonment.



SECTION 2. The above prohibition shall not apply to:
