

ORDINANCE NO. 144A

CITY OF WASHBURN, NORTH DAKOTA

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE USE, DISCHARGE  
OR EXPLOSION OF FIREWORKS WITHIN CITY LIMITS

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Washburn, McLean County,  
North Dakota, as follows:

1. The use, discharge or explosion of fireworks as defined by Section 23-15-01 NDCC, is permitted within the Washburn city limits between the hours of 12:00 o'clock p.m. and 12:00 o'clock a.m., from June 27<sup>th</sup> to July 3<sup>rd</sup>, July 5<sup>th</sup>, from December 26<sup>th</sup> to December 30<sup>th</sup>, and January 1<sup>st</sup>; and is permitted on July 4<sup>th</sup> and December 31<sup>st</sup> from Noon to 2:00 a.m. on July 5<sup>th</sup> and January 1<sup>st</sup> of each year, respectfully.
2. PENALTY. Any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be guilty of an infraction punishable by a fine of Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00).
