

ORDINANCE NO. 144

CITY OF WASHBURN, NORTH DAKOTA

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE USE, DISCHARGE
OR EXPLOSION OF FIREWORKS WITHIN CITY LIMITS

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Commission of the City of Washburn, McLean County,
North Dakota, as follows:

1. The use, discharge or explosion of fireworks as defined by Section 23-15-01 NDCC, not including bottle rockets, is permitted within the Washburn city limits between the hours of 12:00 o'clock p.m. and 12:00 o'clock a.m., from July 1st to July 3rd and on July 5th; and is permitted on July 4th from Noon to 2:00 a.m. on July 5th of each year.
2. PENALTY. Any person who violates the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be guilty of an infraction punishable by a fine of Seventy-five Dollars (\$75.00).
