

ORDINANCE NO. 80

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION IX - LIMITATIONS OF HOURS AND DAYS OF SALE, AND SECTION XVII - PENALTY, OF ORDINANCE No. 69, BEING AN ORDINANCE LICENSING AND REGULATING THE SALE AT RETAIL OF BEER AND LIQUOR AND REPEALING ORDINANCE No. 74.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WASHBURN NORTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. Amendment. That Section IX of Ordinance No. 69 of the City of Washburn, North Dakota, is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

SECTION IX - LIMITATION OF HOURS AND DAYS OF SALE

No licensee licensed pursuant to this ordinance shall sell, serve or permit to be sold, served or consumed on the premises named in the license any intoxicating liquor during the following periods.

1. On Memorial Day, Good Friday, Thanksgiving Day, Christmas Day, or between the hours of 1 o'clock ^{and 8:00 o'clock P.M} A. M. on the day of any statewide, special, primary or general election or between 1 o'clock A. M. and 8 o'clock A. M. on Saturdays and after 1 A. M. o'clock on Sundays and after 6 o'clock P. M. on Christmas Eve.

2. Between 12:01 o'clock A. M. and 8:00 o'clock A. M. on any other day of the week.

Section 2. Amendment. That Section XVII of Ordinance No. 69 of the City of Washburn, North Dakota, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION XVII - PENALTY

Any person found guilty of violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$100.00 or by imprisonment for not to exceed 30 days or both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court.

Section 3. REPEAL

Ordinance No. 74 is hereby repealed.
