Ordinance No. 115

An ordinance adopting certain portions of the NORTH DAKOTA MOTOR VEHICLE LAWS and also establishing certain limitations and rules for the regulation of traffic, which include TRAFFIC ADMINISTRATION; ENFORCEMENT AND OBEDIENCE TO TRAFFIC REGULATIONS; TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES; SPEED REGULATIONS; TURNING MOVEMENTS; ONE-WAY STREETS AND ALLEYS; STOP AND YIELD INTERSECTIONS; MISCELLANEOUS DRIVING RULES; PEDESTRIAN'S RIGHTS AND DUTIES; REGULATIONS FOR MOTORCYCLES; REGULATIONS FOR BICYCLES; ANGLE PARKING; STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING PROHIBITED IN SPECIFIC PLACES; RESERVED PARKING AREAS; TIME LIMIT PARKING ZONES; EQUIPMENT OF VEHICLES; REGULATING THE KINDS AND CLASSES OF TRAFFIC ON CERTAIN ROADWAYS; OPERATION OF SNOWMOBILES; and repealing ordinances and sections of ordinances in conflict therewith.

XXIV. Article XXIV - Repeal

Ordinance(s) No. _____ (inclusive) and all other ordinances and sections of ordinances in conflict herewith are repealed.

XXV. Article XXV - Severability Clause

If any provision of this ordinance or its application to any person, or circumstance is held invalid, the remainder of the ordinance or the application of the provision to other persons or circumstances is not affected.

XXVI. Article XXVI - Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect from and after the _____ day of _____, 19____.

XXVII. Article XXVII - Penalties

Any person who is convicted of violating or of failing to comply with any of the provisions of this ordinance may be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 or by imprisonment not to exceed 30 days, or both and, upon conviction of any person of a violation of Article XIX, § 19-1, Persons under the influence of intoxicating liquor or narcotic drugs not to operate vehicle - Penalty, or § 19-6, Penalty for driving while license suspended or revoked, the court may order the number plate of the motor vehicle owned and operated by the offender at the time of the offense to be impounded by the Sheriff or chief law enforcement officer of the city, as is appropriate, for the duration of the period of suspension of the offender's driver's license or driving privilege by the licensing authority.
