

An Ordinance amending and adding to Ordinance No. 115 relating to the North Dakota Motor Vehicle Laws and establishing certain limitations and rules for the regulation of traffic, which includes STOPPING, STANDING OR PARKING RESTRICTIONS UPON THE CITY STREETS FOR A PERIOD OF MORE THAN FORTY-EIGHT HOURS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WASHBURN, NORTH DAKOTA:

1. There shall be added to Ordinance No. 115: Article XV, Section 14-14 Stopping, Standing, Standing for more than forty eight hours.

It shall be unlawful for anyone to park or leave standing on any public street or highway in the city any vehicle, trailer, or apparatus for a period longer than 48 hours consecutively, provided this section shall not include any area where a shorter time is provided for parking nor shall this section be construed to permit parking for a longer time than is provided in such areas.

2. Any person who is convicted of violating or of failing to comply with any of the provisions of this ordinance may be punished by a fine of not more than \$500.00 or by imprisonment not to exceed 30 days or both.
