BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OF CITY COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF
WASHBURN, NORTH DAKOTA:

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR PUBLIC SAFETY, MORALS AND WELFARE.

RESTRAINT OF MINORS.

That Ordinance No. ~~48~~⁴⁸ being "an Ordinance Prohibiting the Children under the age of ~~eighteen~~ (18) years from being on the streets and public places after certain hours and providing for a penalty for violation thereof" passed on March 9, 1921 be amended and re-enacted to read as follows:

40-01 Loitering of Minors Prohibited.

It shall be unlawful for any minor under the age of ~~seventeen~~^{eighteen} (18) to loiter, idle, wander, stroll or play in or upon the public streets, highways, roads, alleys, parks, playgrounds, or other public grounds, public places and public buildings, places of amusement and entertainment, vacant lots or other unsupervised places, between the hours of 10:00 P.M. and 5:00 A. M. of the following day, official city time; provided, however, that the provisions of this Section do not apply to a minor accompanied by his or her parents, guardian, or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor, or where the minor is upon an emergency errand or legitimate business directed by his or her parents, guardian, or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor. Any minor violating the provisions of this Section shall be dealt with in accordance with Juvenile Court laws and procedure.

40-02 Responsibility of Parents

It shall be unlawful for the parent, guardian or other ~~adult~~^{adult} person having the care and custody of a minor under the age of ~~seventeen~~^{eighteen} (18) years to knowingly permit such minor to loiter, idle, wander, stroll or play in or upon the public streets, highways, roads, alleys, parks, playgrounds, or other public grounds, public places and public buildings, places of amusement and entertainment, vacant lots or other unsupervised places, between the hours of 10:00 P. M. and 5:00 A. M. of the following day, official city time; provided, however, that the provisions of this section do not apply when the minor is accompanied by his or her parents, guardian, or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor, or where the minor is upon an emergency errand or legitimate business directed by his or her parent, guardian, or other adult person having the care and custody of the minor. Any parent, guardian, or other adult person having the care and custody of a minor violating Section 40-01 shall be fined the sum of not more than Ten Dollars (\$10.00) or by imprisonment for not more than ten (10) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment in the discretion of the Court; the Court shall have the power to suspend such sentence and to revoke the suspension thereof. Each violation of the provisions of this section shall constitute a separate offense.

40-03 Minors Prohibited from Purchasing or Possessing Intoxicating Liquor or Beer.

It shall be unlawful for any person under the age of twenty one years to purchase, or attempt to purchase or have in possession, any beer or intoxicating liquor within the city limits of the City of Washburn, N. Dak.
