

ORDINANCE NO. 70

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE CHARGES TO BE MADE FOR USE OF THE SEWER UTILITY OF THE CITY OF WASHBURN, NORTH DAKOTA, ESTABLISHING THE RATES THEREFORE AND PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION THEREOF.

Be it ordained by the City Commission of the City of Washburn, North Dakota.

SECTION I - CHARGE RATE

There is hereby imposed upon all persons whose residence, place of business or establishment is served by the sewer system of the City of Washburn, North Dakota, a charge of \$1.25 per month for the use of said sewer. A penalty of ten percent (10%) shall be imposed upon all users whose accounts are delinquent in excess of 10 days from date of billing.

SECTION 2 - CHARGES AND BILLING

The charges set forth in Section 1 hereof, shall be billed by the City Water Department on the statements redereed for city water and shall be shown as a separate item on each statement and the same shall be paid with the bill for the use of water.

SECTION 3 - COLLECTION OF CHARGES

Each user of said sewer system shall be required to pay such charges within 10 days from date of billing and the same may be collected by civil action or by shutting off of water and sewer service to the person refusing or neglecting to pay same.

SECTION 4 - EFFECTIVE DATE

This ordinance shall take effect and will be in full force on February 1st, 1968.
