

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION IX - LIMITATIONS OF HOURS AND DAYS OF SALE, <sup>- Reenacted</sup> OF ORDINANCE No. 69, BEING AN ORDINANCE LICENSING AND REGULATING THE SALE AT RETAIL OF BEER AND LIQUOR.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF WASHBURN, NORTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. Amendment. That Section IX of Ordinance No. 69 of the City of Washburn, North Dakota, is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

SECTION IX-- LIMITATION OF HOURS AND DAYS OF SALE

No licensee licensed pursuant to this ordinance shall sell, serve or permit to be sold, served or consumed on the premises named in the license any intoxicating liquor during the following periods:

A. WHEN DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME IS IN EFFECT:

1. Between 1:00 o'clock a.m. and 8:00 o'clock a.m. on Saturday, after 1:00 o'clock a.m. on Sunday, Memorial Day, Good Friday or on the day of any general, primary, special or local election held within this City while the polls are open or within one hour thereafter.

2. Between 12:01 o'clock a.m. and 8:00 o'clock a.m. on any other day of the week.

B. WHEN DAYLIGHT SAVING TIME IS NOT IN EFFECT

1. On Sunday, Good Friday, after 6:00 p.m. Christmas Eve, Christmas Day or on the day of any general, primary, special or local election held within this City while the polls are open or within one hour thereafter.

2. Between 12:01 o'clock a.m. and 8:00 o'clock a.m. on any other day of the week.

This amend<sup>m</sup>ent shall be in full force and effect beginning July 1, 1969.
